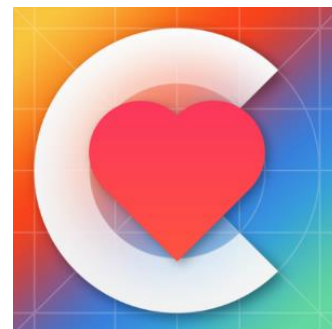

<p><u>Community & a Coffee</u></p> <p>Bennett Rd PS will be partnering with Community Junction Inc. and United Way in providing a casual hour each Wednesday 8.30am – 9.30am for community members to connect with organisations in the school/community. A coffee van will be available and information from these services. The aim is to determine what the needs are of these families and what the school & services can do to meet these.</p> <p>Team Colyton are welcome to attend as a service.</p>	
<p><u>Stepping Stones</u></p> <p>The Stepping Stones project is a Magnetic Places funded program which artist Jan Cleveringa is running in partnership with Team Colyton to install mosaic work at Turner St Park, Colyton.</p> <p>The project is running well with roughly 10 – 14 community members attending. The next workshop is on the 8th April 2018.</p> <p>A theme for the artwork is yet to be decided.</p>	<p>Any ideas for the theme of the artwork to be installed, are to be passed on to Gail or Gloria.</p>
<p><u>Community Colour UP</u></p> <p>The Community Colour UP is a Magnetic Places funded program led by Community Junction Inc in partnership with Colyton Colts & Team Colyton. The project runs ten aerosol/painting workshops to develop art skills to create a Community Mural at CEC Blinkhorn Oval which will be unveiled in a Mural Celebration on Saturday 23rd June 2018 2pm – 5pm.</p>	<p>Team Colyton will support by providing man-power to the Mural Celebration event e.g. running children's activities</p>
