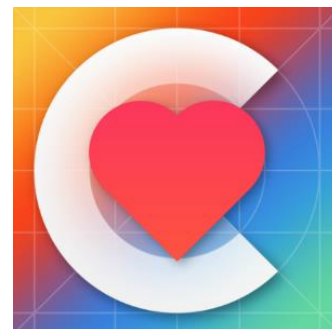

<p><u>Stepping Stones Project</u></p> <p>Jan Cleveringa in partnership with Team Colyton and Community Junction Inc. were successful in \$10,000 of Penrith City Councils Magnetic Places funding to run the Stepping Stones Project.</p> <p>A series of six 2hr workshops to bring the community together through mosaic art at 18 Turner St Park, Colyton. <p><u>Fitness Equipment in Colyton</u></p> <p>Sophia was successful in receiving \$40,000 in Community Builders funding to install fitness equipment at Kevin Maley in Colyton.</p> <p>Penrith City Council will match the \$40,000 to contribute towards the fitness equipment. The equipment will be installed by the end of 2018.</p> <p>Team Colyton members would like to be consulted regarding the implementation of gym equipment, a few ideas were discussed such as a drinking fountain and toilets. <p><u>Prue Carr</u></p> <p>Team Colyton members were asking if there could be a follow up with Prue Carr to come and speak with them at an up and coming meeting. <p><u>Money to plant trees on Carpenter Street</u></p> <p>Sophia was able to give Team Colyton some feedback regarding the funding to implement planting trees on Carpenter street.</p> <p>Sophia advised that no residents on Carpenter street wanted to adopt a tree therefore that resulted in the money being used on the Colyton Colours event that was held at Kevin Maley Park to raise awareness for the importance of trees within the community.</p> <p>Team Colyton would like to continue to investigate potential funding to plant more trees in Colyton.</p>
